



## What's New in the R3000 '1.10.10' Version

*This newest release of software for the R3000 Enterprise Filter requires an R3000 unit running software version 1.10.01 or later.*

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** 8e6 recommends applying the 1.10.10 software at a time when a brief outage in filtering would be acceptable, as an approximate 5-minute outage in R3000 filtering services will occur when executing this upgrade.

### New Feature

- **Novell eDirectory Agent** – This new feature lets you enable the Novell eDirectory Agent option that logs an end user's logon/logoff activity from a Novell eDirectory server if using LDAP authentication. When enabling this feature in the System > Enable/Disable Authentication window, the Default Rule tab in the Group > LDAP > domain > Domain Details window (with the Novell eDirectory Server Type option selected) lets you set up Backup Server Configurations via the wizard pop-up window. To accommodate the Novell eDirectory Agent feature, the View Log File window (available via System > Diagnostics > View Log File) now includes selections for eDirectory Agent Debug Log and eDirectory Agent Event Log for troubleshooting.

### Enhancements to Existing Features

- **Block Page Authentication** (System > Control > Block Page Authentication) – This window now displays under the Block Page Authentication sub-topic in the Control menu. The "NETBIOS User Information" option in the Re-authentication Options field has been removed from this window.
- **Operation Mode** (System > Mode > Operation Mode) – The Listening Device and Block Page Device frames have been reorganized in the window to now display beside each other.
- **Enable/Disable Authentication** (System > Enable/Disable Authentication) – The 8e6 Authenticator can now be downloaded via the "Download 8e6 Authenticator" link in the 8e6 Authenticator frame.
- **Radius Authentication Settings** (System > Radius Authentication Settings) – The window has been reorganized with new labels. The Radius Authentication Settings frame now includes all options for configuring Radius authentication that formerly displayed in the Byte Order Mode, Forward Mode, and Reply Mode frames.
- **Customization** (System > Customization) – This topic displays in the System section of the Administrator console, and includes the following sub-topics in its menu: Common Customization, Authentication Form, Lock Page, Block Page, and Profile Control. Formerly, these menu items were included as tabs in the Block, Lock and Authentication Customization window, accessible via the Control menu.

- **Override Account and Time Profile pop-up windows** (Group > IP group) – A pop-up window containing tabs now opens when creating or modifying an override account or time profile filtering profile. The Apply and Close buttons are included on each of the tabs. Previously, these tabs displayed in the Override Account or Time Profile window. Click the View/Modify button to open the pop-up window for editing an override account or time profile.
- **Upload/Download Global/IP Profile** (Group > Global/IP group) – The window has been reorganized so that the buttons for uploading and downloading profiles (and Reloading a global profile) now display beneath the IP Profile Management frame instead of within the frame.
