



## What's New in the R3000 '1.10.15' Version

*This newest release of software for the R3000 Enterprise Filter requires an R3000 unit running software version 1.10.10 or later.*

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** 8e6 recommends applying the 1.10.15 software at a time when a brief outage in filtering would be acceptable, as an approximate 5-minute outage in R3000 filtering services will occur when executing this upgrade.

### New Features

- **TAR Agent** – Builds in support for communication with the upcoming Threat Analysis Reporter (TAR) product.

### Enhancements to Existing Features

- **Authentication -> Tier 1 / 8e6 Authenticator** – Performance enhancements to improve authentication request handling during peak loads.
- **Activating an LDAP Directory** (Group > LDAP > Domain Details) – Modifies the existing query that the R3000 will run when attempting to activate a domain. This is to address certain environments where the original query was too specific and would be rejected based on the LDAP user permissions on the R3000 account. This should allow the R3000 to successfully activate a domain more reliably.

### Bug Fixes

- **Authentication -> Tier 2 / 3** – Fixes an issue with cookie handling that could prevent the Authentication Request Form from displaying.
- **Override Account Timeout** – Addresses an issue where the override account would not timeout if the profile pop-up window was blocked by a pop-up blocker. In version 1.10.15, if the pop-up window is blocked, the profile automatically times out in the next two minutes.
- **8e6 CIPA Rule Modification** (Group > Global Group > Rules) – Fixes an issue where the rule number was not properly assigned when modifying\* this rule (\*This rule cannot be modified, but you will be prompted to create a new name for the modified version of this rule).
