



## What's New in the ER Server '3.50.30' Version

*The 3.50.30 software release of the Enterprise Reporter Server has a momentary impact on Internet reporting when this patch is applied to the server, and contains the following changes since the previous patch:*

### New Features

- **NIC mode screen** – This new option has been added to the Server menu for standalone ER units and includes separate NIC settings for eth0 and eth1, along with the 1000baseT-Full Duplex selection—if available for the ER unit. The mii-tool and ethtool are available to check the speed and connection of the NIC(s).
- **Web Client Server Management screen** – This new option has been added to the Server menu and lets the administrator restart the Web Client server from the front end.
- **NAS Status screen** – This new option has been added to the Database menu, and indicates the status of the NAS unit, if available.

### Fixes and Enhancements

- **Tools screen** – Additional logs have been included in the Database Status drop-down menu.
- **Secure Access screen** – Only port 1 can now be added instead of multiple port numbers.
- **Shutdown screen** – When shutting down or rebooting the server, a message now displays to let the user know this may take awhile.
- **Server enhancements** – Enhancements were made to the backup process, daily traffic table, and for monitoring the status of the ER.
- **Web Client enhancements** – Enhancements were made to the Date Scope field, Event Schedule, and various reports.
